Hello from Nairobi!

Deb and I returned to Nairobi yesterday from our 1300 km 9-day journey across Kenya in our little Corolla. Many of the roads in Kenya have actually improved since last year, so we are grateful for that!

Most of the ministry teams we visited were doing well. Jesse (our son!) and his partner (Joe) were actually among the few that were struggling. Their ministry assignment requires a lot of preaching and speaking---sometimes 4+ times per day---quite a lot for 2 quiet introverts! We asked their host pastor if there is a way to reduce the amount of speaking. A few days later, Jesse told us that while the schedule hasn't really changed, he and Joe have been adapting better.

One of our students--Katie Black--required an emergency appendectomy last Saturday. She is now recovering at her host family's home in Nairobi. We are thankful for the good medical care she received and that she is healing well. Praise God!!

Deb and I have a lot of "To Do's" in the next few days before the students all return to Nairobi. Please be praying for us in the middle of all the details in preparation for the next phase of our team's ministry. Continue praying as well for the students in their ministry assignments. They are in their final week of service and outreach!
