The First Presbyterian Church of Whitefish was not only a place of worship, but also a community meeting place, recreational center, education facility, and base of operations for the congregation's considerable service work. Designed by Spokane architects Archibald Rigg and Roland Vantyne, the building is a remarkable local example of Romanesque Revival church architecture.
